### **14.10.2010 Thursday**

- 15.00 – Guests welcoming in reception hall,
- 19.00 – Transport of guests to a dinner in the restaurant **Miód i Wino** („Honey and Wine”)
- 19.30 – Ceremonial welcoming of guests, speech of the **President of CLIMMAR**

### **15.10.2010 Friday**

- 09.00 – Visit of **Kościuszko heap** and watching morning panorama of the city
- 10.45 – Morning coffee in most beautiful cafe in the city - **Noworolski Cafe**
- 11.15 – Sightseeing in the **Old Town** with the scope of introducing the historical as well as modern dimension of Krakow. Apart from standard attractions such as: Barbican, Czartoryski Museum – Floriańska Stress – Old Market - Mariacki Church– University – Franciskaner Church – we will present more hidden, typically Cracow, charming lanes and alleys. The planned visiting of Mariacki Church, in the moment of the ceremonial opening of the Wit Stwosz altar at 12.00 a.m.
- 13.00 – Visit of **Wawel Castle**, entering the Cathedral (also Smocza Jama – dragon’s cave)
- 13.45 – Ride by horse-driven cabs to the old Jewish quarter - **Kazimierz**.

- 14.00 – Lunch at Szeroka street and a 40-minute **klezmer music concert** .
- 15.45 – Walk through Kazimierz: Szeroka Street, entrance to the **Remuh synagogue, Remuh cemetery**, later Nowy Square
- 16.45 – Visit to one of the best **Cracow bakery** (with degustation of bread and pastry)
- 17.00 – **Photographic projection** of beautiful and old photos of the city, on one of the walls of the old residential buildings, the closing of the event, warm drinks consumption (outside by a good weather, by bad weather - inside, in cafe Kawiarnia Naukowa, Jakuba Street or Satori - Józefa Street)
- 18.00 – Return to hotel
- 20.00 – Joint dinner on **Vistula**, in the unique place created by the Cracow artist and madcaps – on the **19th century barge**
- 21.45 – Fire show at Vistula riverbank
